You can use audience filters to limit the types of content you see while browsing and searching your library's digital collection:

In your library's digital collection, go to your **Settings** page under **My account**. Under **Audience(s)**, select the types of content you'd like to see while browsing and searching. You can choose one or more of these filters:

- **Juvenile:** Fiction and nonfiction titles for children.
- **Young adult:** Fiction and nonfiction titles for young adults.
- **General adult:** General fiction and nonfiction.
- **Mature adult:** Fiction and nonfiction for readers over the age of 18.
