## **Questions:**

- 1. There were questions regarding the feasibility of doing the boring add alt due to the slope of the hill.
  - a. Directional boring is an acceptable construction means and methods for this location.
- 2. Was it discovered where the connection was regarding the plans. Was it verified against the plans.
  - a. The contractor will need to pothole and field verify both connection points.
- 3. The drawings list 90-degree bends, do you want 90 or (2) 45s? Contractors haven't been installing 90s bends for a few years.
  - a. Proposing 45-degree bends are acceptable in lieu of 90-degree bends.
- 4. In the scope of work, it says to leave the joints open for pressure testing. Do we want that?
  - a. Pressure testing as recommended is acceptable.
- 5. What location do engineers want to do the backflow and hydrostatic testing?
  - a. The testing can be done near the connection points.
- 6. Bid bonds were not listed in the RFP. Does this project require them?
  - a. No, they are not required for this project.
- 7. Will the road be closed?
  - a. Yes, the side service road will be closed while construction is ongoing.
- 8. Can we price using weekends to not close the road? Are there deliveries on the weekend?
  - a. No need to submit the price for weekend work since the road will be closed for this project.
